Introducing Business Check via API



BusinessCheck is a lookup service for accessing address and credit details for individuals and businesses. Bricknode has been a vendor for BusinessCheck since 2013 with the service being available within the [Customer Acquisition](#) module. As of the release which is Sandbox-ready on the 7th of April the BusinessCheck calls will be available via our API as well.

Full Nordnet integration



Bricknode has worked towards improving its capabilities with regards to supporting external custodians and trading venues. On the 7th of April Bricknode is releasing full support for what we call mirror accounts with [Nordnet](#). This means that customer accounts which are located with Nordnet can be both viewed and controlled via Bricknode Financial Systems ("BFS"). Instead of just being able to view current positions and transactions within BFS a user can now create mutual fund orders which will be executed within Nordnet.
